This is Jin-suck Suh, a professor of department of radiology, college of medicine Yonsei university. I graduated from college of medicine Yonsei University in 1979 and took the radiology training in Severance Hospital, Yonsei University. I had opportunities for a few oversea visit reserches at University of Minnesota and University of Pennsylvania during 1990-1992, and at Stanford University in 2000. I took musculoskeletal imaging as my subspecialty and continued to study further, focusing on metal induced MR imaging artifacts. With regard to the researches, I gave my efforts on investigating the MR contrast agent (iron oxide nanoparticles) development, having proven the concept of targeted cancer molecular imaging for personalized therapy. For this work I was awarded 2007 South Korean highest scientific technical increase. I was honored as Avison Distinguished Professor, 2011-2014 in Yonsei University and Korea's Frontier Research Scientist, named by The Korean Academy of Science and Technology (KAST) 2011.

I did my active roles in several professional society; Board members of Korean Society of Radiology, President of Korean Society of Molecular Imaging, Board member, Secretary general, vice president of Korean society of magnetic resonance in medicine (KSMRM) since 2000, and I continued to serve as the president of KSMRM 2014- 2016 and congress chair of international congress for magnetic resonance imaging (ICMRI) 2015 and 2016.
